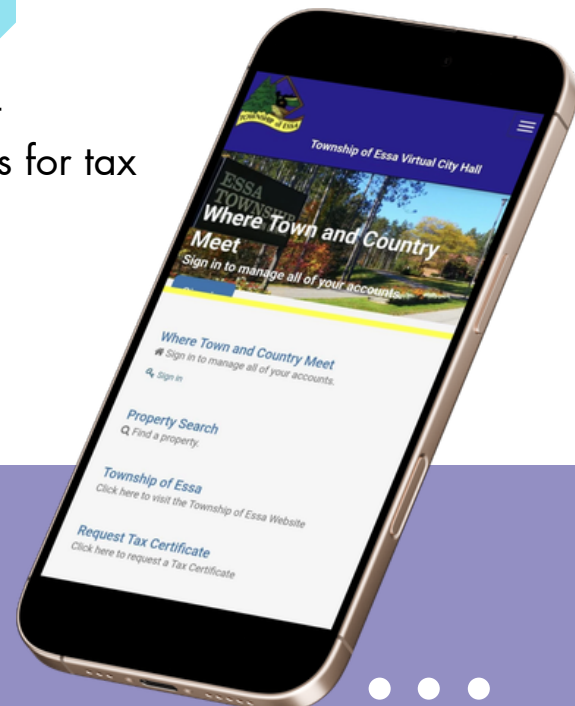
Pre-Authorized Payment Plan

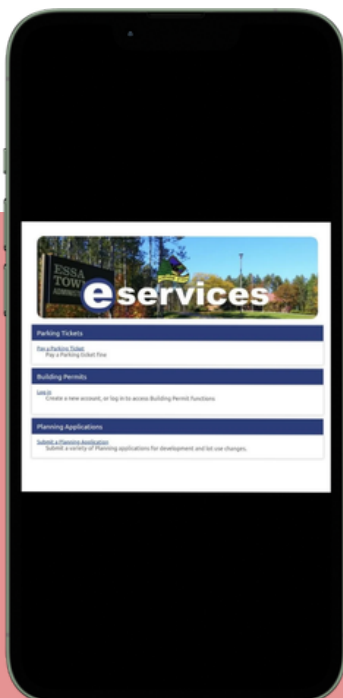

Parking

Parking is regulated under the Township's Parking By-law. Always check posted signs before parking, as restrictions may apply based on time or location.

Winter Parking Restrictions

From November 1 to May 1, overnight parking is not permitted between 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on any street, highway or sidewalks, even if there is no snow. Violators may be ticketed or towed.

Burn Permits

A valid Burn permit is required if you have a recreational or outdoor fire.
